## Matters arising from correspondence -

- **Biodiversity Duty**- Correspondence received from parishioners concerning the biodiversity duty and recommendations by SNPC. Dog walkers concerned that the long grass along the footpath between St. Giles Road and Church Lane that due to the length of the grass there is nowhere to step aside from other dog walkers along the path if the dogs are not friendly towards each other. Also, comments received that due to the length of the grass along this area and along the verge of St. Giles Road it is difficult to collect the excrement of the dog in the long grass and where the Parish Council is trying to reduce the amount of dog mess in the parish it seems that

this measure will only increase it as it is difficult to collect the said excrement and see it all. Maybe the grass/banking could be left unmown at the back of the verge and still trimmed at the front to allow passing along the footpath and collection of dog waste. Additional concerns also that Ticks are always an issue in the warmer weather within the woodland and leaving the long grass could also increase their presence so an area to step aside that is mown would also be of benefit. The Village Hall has also voted on not being able to keep their grass long due to the nature of the use of the facility and insurance conditions as this could possibly increase the risk of an accident due to the uneven nature of the ground.
